## Help with food shopping

### Shop Mobility scheme

If you're visiting a shopping mall or a supermarket, there may be a shop mobility scheme or electric wheelchair or cart available for you to hire or loan. Ask at your local supermarkets.

### Help during your shopping trip

Supermarkets may offer an assisted shopping service to help you shop. Check with your supermarket to see if it's something they do. If they offer it, you'll need to book this in advance, so staff are available.

### Grocery deliveries (order online)

Many supermarkets and food shops can deliver food to your door on a day you choose (may need to book in advance).

### Tesco Whoosh deliveries (order online)

- Same-day home delivery from your local Tesco Express. Choose from everyday essentials, meals and more and a local delivery partner will deliver in from as little as 20 minutes.

### Morrisons deliveries (order online or by telephone)

- **Regular online orders:** home delivery service with convenient 1-hour delivery windows.
- **On-demand online orders:** choose from over 500 grocery items from Morrisons stores for delivery via Deliveroo in as little as 30 minutes.
- **Doorstep delivery** for vulnerable, shielding or self-isolating customers: order by telephone, choose from 47 essential items for delivery next day. Call 0345 611 6111 and select option five.
