

Norfolk & Waveney Agreed Fair Usage Policy Stoma Miscellaneous Appliances

This policy has been developed in collaboration with Clinical Nurse Specialists at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital King's Lynn, The Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital, The James Paget University Hospital and local community stoma nurses.

- **New products should ONLY be initiated by Hospital/Community Stoma team.**
- **Retrospective & prospective prescription requests for new items from dispensers should be declined.**
- **GP Practices should ensure they have written confirmation from a Hospital/Community nurse prior to issuing a prescription.**
- **Please ensure double quantity prescriptions are not released for holiday seasons.**

Adhesive Removers Sprays	Sprays are more cost effective than wipes. Generally, prescribe one type but might need occasional both spray/wipes as directed by stoma nurse.

Adhesive Remover Wipes	Wipes may be more suitable for people with poor dexterity or two-piece stoma bags.		
	Lifteez Salts wipes	60321 WAP2	1 single wipe per pouch (1 box per 30 pouches)
Barrier Wipes (films, foams sticks)	Short-term use only via Clinical Nurse Specialist (usually 3 months) All barrier preparations are on specialist advice.		
	Medicare Derma S wipes Salts wipes Guard non-sting film sachets Independence Fusion applicator	60307 PPS1 RMC3 BW2	One pack for every 30 bags based on clinical need as assessed by Nurse BW2 not to be routinely used
Barrier Sprays	For peri-anal soreness, anal dilation soreness, peristomal breakdown.

Other Barriers e.g. creams	For mucocutaneous hypersensitivity, Cancer patients & complex dermatological conditions. The ICB does NOT support the prescribing of SACHETS these are classified on the traffic light system as BLACK i.e., not for primary care prescribing.

Discharge Solidifying gels	Sometimes described as thickening gels. Consider second and third line in patients with chemotherapy induced diarrhoea, jejunostomy

Irrigation Kits accessories	Complete kits provided by Trust Stoma nurses. GP to prescribe replacement accessories.		
	Coloplast OR Dansac including accessories		These should last up to 6 months.
Lubricating gels	Lubricating deodorising gels via clinical nurse specialist. These are used as a lubricant, not deodoriser as they help to reduce pancaking. The ICB does not support the prescribing of the sachets		

	Brava lubricating Bottle Adapt	12061 78500	1 bottle lasts approximately 3 months
Seals /Barrier Rings	These are mouldable and help prevent leaks. PS Check to see if still needed before issuing a repeat prescription

Support Wear	Levels 2- 3 belts are supported by the ICB. These should only be prescribed following an assessment by Clinical Nurse Specialist. The ICB does not support the prescribing of Level 1 support undergarments or vests
