# Information for patients, carers and families

#### **Community Nursing team**

If you have any concerns around symptoms (pain, breathlessness, nausea, restlessness) then please contact a district nurse.

They can administer the injectable anticipatory, (just in case) medications. District nurses also support with catheter care, pressure area care, wound care etc. District Nurses aim to arrive within two hours following your phone call, but this is not guaranteed.
