What is a SNOMED Clinical Term?

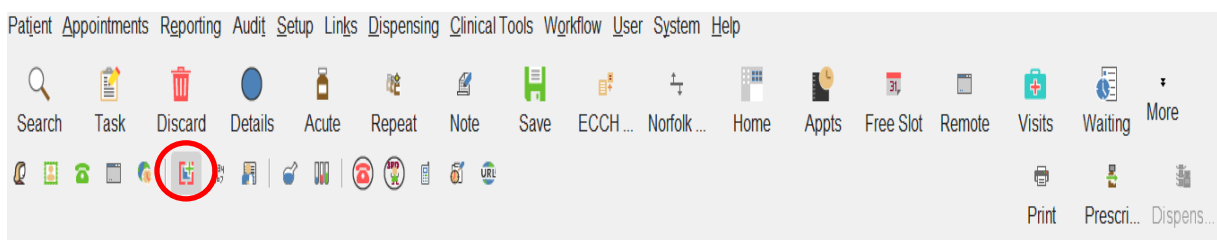
SNOMED CT is a structured clinical vocabulary for use in an electronic health record. It is the most comprehensive and precise clinical health terminology product in the world.

It is important to add the correct SNOWMED Clinical Term when setting up electronic repeat dispensing prescriptions. This allows practices to be able to search patient data to identify which of their patients are using the electronic repeat dispensing service.

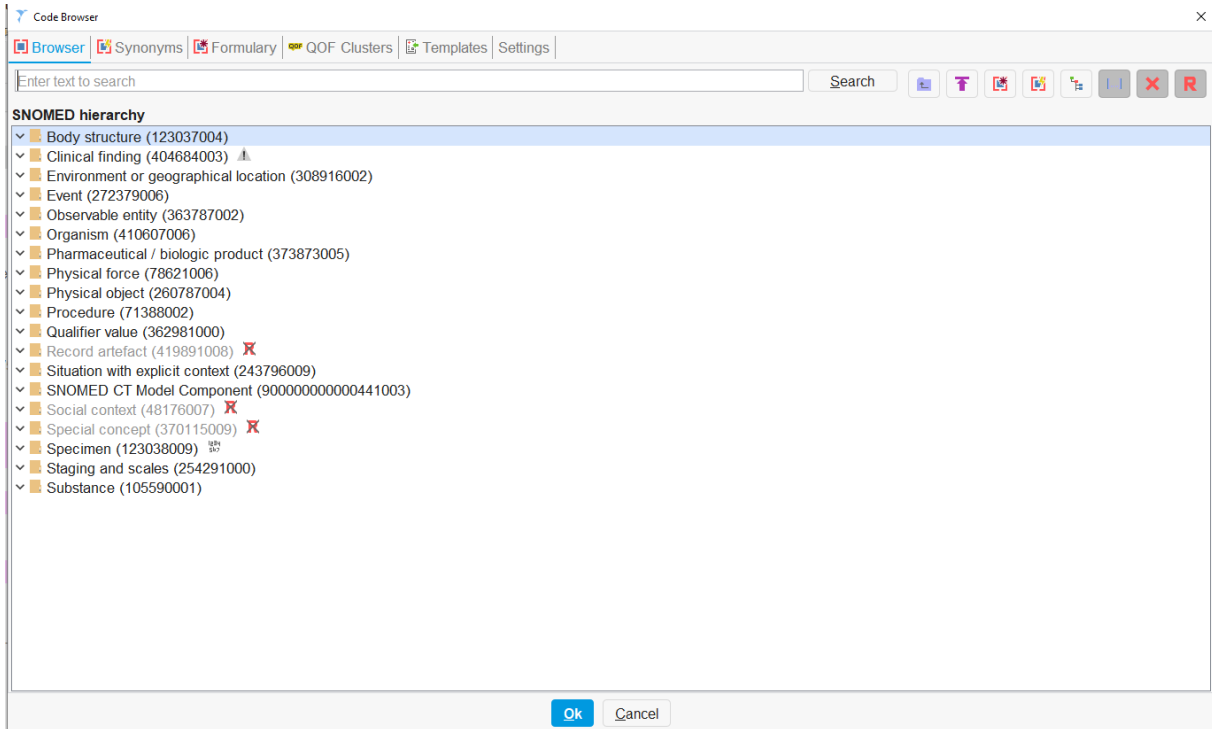

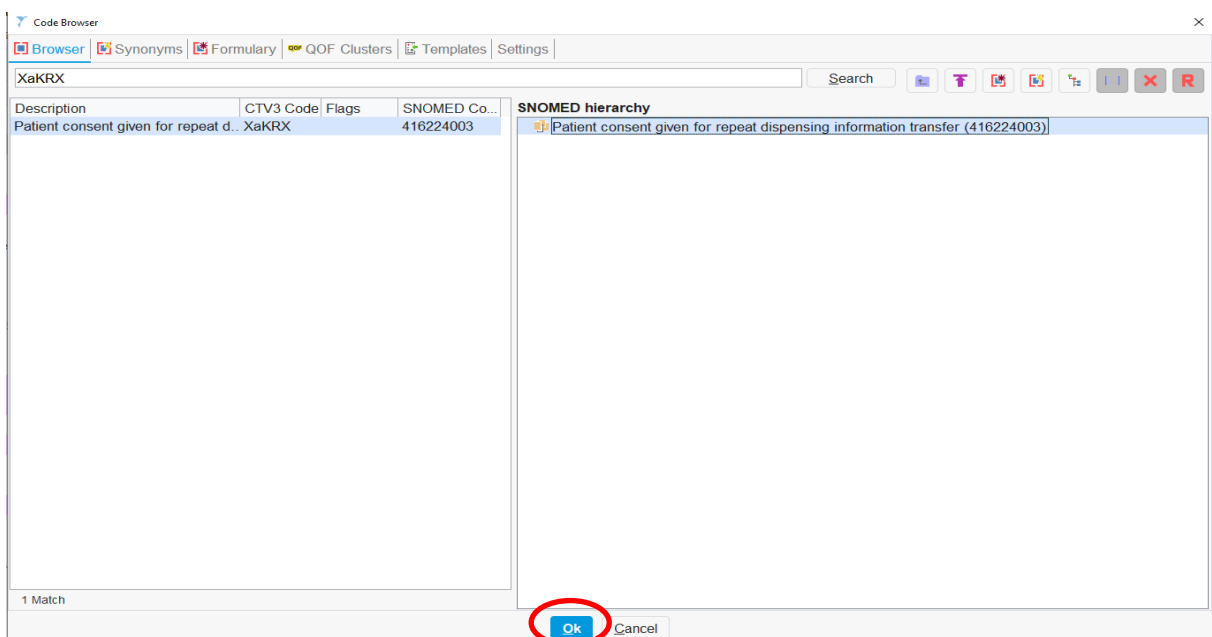
1. Click on the Read code browser (circled below)




- Type in the CTV3 or SNOMED CT code for your action and press search e.g. if patient has agreed to eRD type in **XaKRX**;



- Highlight the option and press OK
