An estimated £300m*

of unused medicines are wasted every year across the UK.

Of the £300m worth of unused medicines, it's estimated that:

- £110m is being returned to pharmacies because it's not needed
- •£90m is being stored unused in people's homes

• £50m is disposed of in care homes

Providing NHS services

Once an unwanted medicine has left the pharmacy, it cannot be used even if it's not been opened.

By reducing the amount of medicines being wasted each year, we could increase the available funding for other vitally needed health services.
